Our linked Head is called Constantine! (Constant for short) and our partnership has been so successful it is being proclaimed as a bit of a flagship with the British Council both here and in Rwanda. The link was further cemented last week when Tom Kok, one of our Governors, organised a business conference in the capital city, Kigali, and invited Constant and a student along. He was then invited to stay in Constant's home. I was thrilled to receive this e-mail and want to say a huge "Thank you" to Tom for having such a wonderful impact. "To be honest, Tom overwhelmed me with his exceptional personality. He is so good that I can't have words to tell you. I and Esther (My selected student) attended the AvisAssist workshop in Kigali. It was the first time that Esther ever stepped in Kigali. Tom treated us so well though we were not the professionals in aviation. It was Inspiring to the student because it provided a motivation to understand that she has something to struggle for in Education. The most special thing is that I hosted Tom at home with my family. Tell you what, everyone still talks about him. The family loved him a lot. Actually although he spent just a night, he left a big impact and we miss him a lot. Tom is ultra-magnetic personality you can't resist his charm. My 3 daughters sang for him to bid him farewell. I think he will tell the rest of the story of how he spent his time in Rwanda."
