BIG DRAW BOATANICALS WORKSHOP: On Monday 13th March we are having our Big Draw Botanicals workshop: Bringing nautical and floral elements together through 3D drawings. This year the Big Draw project presented by Falmouth University, will be run by Foundation Diploma Art & Design students and staff in collaboration with local schools. The Big Draw is an international festival and charity that seeks to involve the local community in the act of drawing (please see link to website <http://thebigdraw.org>). 'Botanical' brings together both the nautical and floral elements of the Cornish environment in a display of 3 dimensional drawings made from recycled materials. Through involving the local community and running workshops in local schools and as part of the Princess Pavilions 'Make and take' workshops we hope to create hundreds of 'Botanical' 3D flowers that can become part of our own Flower show installation on the 18th March, (the work will be installed on the 16th March). The show will be displayed in the gardens of the Princess Pavilions and will coincide with the spring flower show. It will remain open to the public for the duration of the Spring Festival, until the 17th April. The workshop organisers have asked that every child brings in a plastic bottle - any size. Please bring these in as soon as possible (more if you have them) so we can ensure we have enough on the day.
