PUPIL PREMIUM: The school is entitled to pupil premium funding from the government for children who are adopted, children who are entitled to free school meals and children whose parents are in the armed forces. We hold details on our school database of these children. However your circumstances may have changed and you may be entitled to claim free school meals if you are in receipt of certain benefits. We have enclosed a form on the back of this newsletter which sets out these benefits and if you feel you are entitled to claim then please complete the form and return to school by **Monday 9 January 2017**. Children who are in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 receive Universal Free School Meals, but if you also receive the benefits listed you could qualify for pupil premium which means once your child is in Year 3 you will continue with free school meals.
