Castles, enchantment, stories galore! - The children's imaginations will be running wild with this fantasy topic. They will study enchanted stories from our own and other cultures. A visit to Pendennis Castle and appreciation of local gardens will help to fuel their own imaginations. They will look at forces and materials as they look at how castles are constructed and how draw bridges work and in DT use junk modelling to make a castle. ICT will be used for simulations programming robots around imaginary castles or gardens; and also for story writing. The children will study the weather and climate, both for their importance to gardens and also for their ability to create moods in enchanted places.

As Christmas approaches the children will study the enchanting story of the Nativity and through this look at the importance of family at this magical time.
