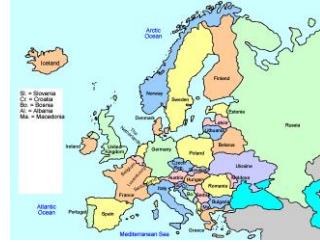


# European Discovery optional homework grid

Research and plan your ideal holiday in Europe. Where would you go? What activities would you do? How would you travel there? You may want to work out the costings too!



Write a quiz to quiz a friend about the different countries in Europe. E.g capital cities, foods, languages etc.



Research your family tree and find out which family members were alive in WW2. Can you find out anything else about them? Did any of them serve in the army?

Using an atlas or the internet, choose a European country and draw a map of it, labelling its main cities and landmarks.



Research how has Britain changed since 1940? Find facts e.g. salary changes, house prices, wages, education etc. Think carefully how you want to present your work – you could make it into a presentation to show the class.

Research a famous European artist and create your own drawing or painting in a similar style.



Create Top Trump cards of European landmarks/capital cities/ivers.

Research and create your own model of a famous landmark in Europe OR an air raid shelter.



Cook a meal/pudding/snack that has particular links to a European country. (You could use a recipe you've learnt in school).
