

## Autumn Term 2017 Curriculum Letter

What will we be learning in Lerryn Class?







## Topic: Fire, Food and Festivals

Through this topic the children will start with the Great Fire of London, examining the causes and consequences of the event. We will compare life in 1666 to today, comparing and charting the children's favourite foods and explore where they come from, take a close look at bread, and examine the range of restaurants in local towns. Lerryn will look at the geographical location and climatic features which affect the types of food that are grown and consumed, and at balanced diets and healthy eating. We will explore stories and histories of the places that they encounter, triggering their imagination and deepening their understanding of different beliefs. By the end of term we will be preparing for our Nativity play and comparing Christmas around the world. The topic will also require lots of cooking and eating!

For Maths we follow the National Curriculum – details can be found on our website. In RE we follow the Cornwall Agreed Syllabus, and will be learning about Jesus this term. We will let you know about our educational visits for the term soon.
