Times Tables

Dear Parents,

A secure knowledge of times table multiplication and division facts is essential in order to be able to progress through the Primary Curriculum for mathematics.

National Curriculum guidance states that:

- By the end of Year 2, a child should know the 2, 5 and 10 times tables
- By the end of Year 3, a child should know the 3, 4 and 8 times tables
- By the end of Year 4 a child should know by heart and be able to recall with speed and accuracy all times table facts up top 12 x 12 and their associated division facts.

Obviously, all children learn and different speeds and some children find learning and remembering times table facts easier than others. With this in mind, I have compiled a list of resources that you and your child may find useful to support learning times tables facts.

Regular practise is essential if your child is still insecure with their times table facts.

I hope you will find these resources useful and enjoy using them with your child to ensure that they know and sharpen all their times table facts.
