For reasons of safety we are unable to administer medicines to children at school. Usually if a child needs medication he/she should be kept at home until he/she is fit to return. Alternatively, parents/carers may come into school to give medication, if necessary, by prior arrangement with the Principal or call at the office to make alternative arrangements. Children with medical conditions, e.g. asthma, diabetes, etc., can have their medicines in school (to be taken by themselves or assisted by a member of staff), on condition that we have written instructions from the parent.
